Issuance of a Swiss JAR-FCL PPL(H) VFR/IR single pilot type rating helicopter (Conversion of a foreign licence)

Requirements for the issuance of a Swiss JAR-FCL PPL(H) VFR single pilot type rating helicopter issued on the basis of an ICAO-PPL(H) VFR single pilot type rating helicopter issued in a non-JAA-state

- JAR FCL medical certificate class 2 issued by an authorised Swiss FOCA AME
- Theoretical examination PPL(H) subjects "10/air law" and "40/human performance" in accordance with JAR-FCL 2
- Proof of the radiotelephony qualification entered in the foreign pilot's licence
- Proof of the language proficiency (at least Level 4) entered in the foreign pilot's licence (if not demonstrated, the rights of the licence holder will be restricted according to AIC B 003/08)
- Minimum total flying hours experience: 100 hours as pilot of helicopters
- Skill test PPL(H) VFR with examiner on single pilot type rating helicopter as set out in Appendix 1 to JAR-FCL 2.130 and 2.135 and Appendix 2 to JAR-FCL 2.135 and according "FOCA Guide to skill test and proficiency check helicopter"
- Application for the issuance of a pilot's licence/permit (FOCA Form.60.975)
- Copies of all pages of the current and valid foreign pilot's licence with entry of the required type rating (pending licence is not accepted)
- Copies of all pages of the foreign medical certificate
- Copies of last 3 pages of the logbook
- Copy of passport
- Official printout of criminal record file issued by state of residence (max. 3 months old)

Additional requirements to obtain a Swiss JAR-FCL IR single pilot type rating helicopter issued on the basis of the foreign IR single pilot type rating helicopter

- Copy of the IR entered in the current foreign pilot's licence (pending licence is not accepted)
- Pass all subjects of the theoretical IR examination in accordance with JAR-FCL 2
- Proof of the language proficiency (at least Level 4) entered in the foreign pilot's licence
- Minimum total flying hours experience: 100 hours instrument flight time
- Skill test IR

Verification of the foreign pilot's licences and medical certificates

By filling the application form 60.975, the applicant will authorize the issuing Civil Aviation Authorities of his foreign licences and medical certificates to provide all relevant information for the corresponding application to the Swiss Federal Office of Civil Aviation (FOCA)
